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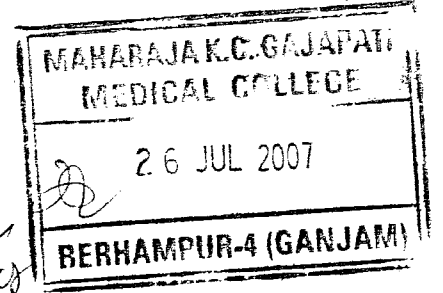

Subject :- Increase of seats in MBBS course from 107 to 150 students at M.K.C.G. Medical College, Brahmapur, Ganjam – Permission of the Central Government – Regarding.

Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of intent of even number dated 13th July, 2007 and with reference to your letter No. 18306/H, dated 14th July, 2007 on the above subject, I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Government to increase in MBBS seats from 107 to 150 at M.K.C.G. Medical College, Brahmapur, Ganjam, Orissa for the academic year 2007-08 under Section 10 (A) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, as amended.

2. This permission of the Central Government for increase in MBBS seats is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievement of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time expansion of hospital/medical college facilities against increase in seats are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India. The college shall not admit more than one batch of students against this letter of permission. The college shall also apply to Medical Council of India for renewal of permission well before the commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievement in terms of infrastructure, staff and equipment as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as required by Medical Council of India norms must be clearly indicated. The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Government.

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3. The admission process for the academic year, 2007-08 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 1997, as amended.
